



## DAY TEN 1 John 2:3-6 - Walk As Jesus Walked

“This is how we are sure that we have come to know Him: by keeping His commands. The one who says, “I have come to know Him,” yet doesn't keep His commands, is a liar, and the truth is not in him. But whoever keeps His word, truly in him the love of God is perfected. This is how we know we are in Him: The one who says he remains in Him should walk just as He walked.”

“Jesus replied: “‘Love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your mind.’ This is the first and greatest commandment. And the second is like it: ‘Love your neighbor as yourself.’” Mathew 22: 37-39

- < God is Love, He loved us, even when we were sinners
- < God commands us to Love God and to love people
- < We can't pretend we love God if we can't love the people He puts before us.

Jesus' example of obedience gives us direction.

(Matthew 6:9-13), “Pray, then, in this way: ‘Our Father, who art in heaven, . . . thy will be done...’ we are to always be seeking His will.

Jesus came to earth to do the Father's will. “‘My food is to do the will of Him who sent Me and to finish His work,’” John 4:34

Our food is also to do the will of the Father and to finish the work of the kingdom.

Jesus Christ is our example by His own life and the path we are to choose. Our life is to be completely in line with every Word of God and thus the will of God.

- < Jesus appoints those He loves, values and wants them to serve with Him
- < Jesus gives authority and power to those He loves and appoints
- < Those He appoints He equips for the job
- < Those He appoints He values and believes they are up to the task
- < Jesus loved us so much that He gave His life for us.
- < Are we ready to give over our life for His Kingdom.

Lay down our desires to seek His.
